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News Highlights

- *Widespread rain and thunderstorms are forecast across East, Central, West, Northeast and South India till early October, with isolated heavy to very heavy rainfall in Odisha, Maharashtra, Telangana, Assam and nearby regions. Strong surface winds are also likely over coastal and interior parts during this period.*
- *Heavy rains lashed several districts in Karnataka in 24 hrs, including Gulbarga, Bijapur, Bidar, Bagalkot, Yadgir, and Raichur. Parts of Vidarbha in Maharashtra, especially Solapur and Latur, also witnessed torrential downpours.*
- *Vessel Update: The vessel “M.V. VTC DRAGON” carrying 19,929.780 MT of Pigeon Peas (Tur) in bags from Mozambique is expected to arrive at Mumbai Port on October 4, 2025, as per shipping agency reports.*
- *The urad crop is very weak; its quality is generally fair to good, but recent rains have caused the quality to deteriorate slightly.*
- *Australia’s chickpea harvest has begun in Queensland and is set to start in about four weeks in New South Wales. Strong winter rains have boosted crop prospects, prompting ABARES to raise the national forecast to 2.1 million MT. Yields around areas like Mungindi on the Qld–NSW border look solid, with crops still flowering and podding without moisture stress. The main harvest window in southern Queensland and northern New South Wales is expected from late October to mid-November, while export activity is currently focused on early Queensland supplies.*
- *Chickpea prices have slumped, with new-crop Brisbane delivery well below last year’s levels and early Central Queensland sales losing their premium. Wheat and barley are now offering better margins, making growers cautious. With prices still dropping daily, chickpeas may struggle to compete with cereals for sales in the coming months despite good production prospects.*
- *Global Weather :For OND 2025, a La Niña-influenced pattern is expected, with below-normal rainfall over the central and eastern Pacific, southern Europe, parts of Africa, and southern North America, while above-normal rainfall is likely over the Indian subcontinent, Southeast Asia, the Maritime Continent, eastern Australia, northern North America, and a band near 60°S in the southern Pacific.*

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
