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### News Highlights

- Summer is advancing across India, with rising temperatures in Delhi and other major cities. The India Meteorological Department has forecast rain, hail, and gusty winds of 30–40 km/h, with temperatures in the plains likely to dip by 2–3°C amid unsettled weather conditions.
- The Centre has approved Rabi 2026 gram procurement of 0.761 million MT (Maharashtra), 0.58 million MT (Madhya Pradesh), 0.553 million MT (Rajasthan) and 0.413 million MT (Gujarat), along with 0.601 million MT of masoor for Madhya Pradesh, under Pradhan Mantri Annadata Aay Sanrakshan Abhiyan, while procurement of tur, urad and masoor will continue until 2030–31.
- Under the Price Support Scheme (PSS) for Rabi 2026, the Centre has approved procurement of 0.761 million MT of gram for Maharashtra, 0.58 million MT for Madhya Pradesh, 0.553 million MT for Rajasthan, and 0.413 million MT for Gujarat, while procurement of tur, urad and masoor will continue under the Pulses Self-Reliance Mission through central agencies until 2030–31.
- Kabuli chickpea production in India for the 2026–27 crop season is estimated to decline by around 11.5% to 0.575 million MT, according to estimates presented by the Madhya Pradesh Kabuli Chana Trade Association Indore. In the previous 2025–26 season, production was about 0.65 million MT, with trade experts indicating a likely decline of nearly 0.075 million MT in the upcoming season.
- Global: Weather conditions remain warm and dry across Europe, while the United States is experiencing very warm temperatures with some rainfall over the Plains. Conditions are mixed in South America. In Australia, forecast rainfall has shifted into southern New South Wales, Victoria and South Australia.
- The U.S. Department of Agriculture will purchase \$263 million in farm products, including \$75 million for pulses—covering beans, peas, lentils, and chickpeas—to support growers in the United States and supply food banks nationwide.
- Global edible oil prices showed a declining trend. Malaysian palm oil prices eased in the evening session, while Chicago soyoil futures also recorded losses. Traders noted that Bursa Malaysia crude palm oil (CPO) futures softened on Wednesday due to weak export demand and ample overall supplies.

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
