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News Highlights

- Meteorologists warn that El Niño may develop by August, potentially affecting the second half of India's monsoon. However, scientists from the India Meteorological Department say it is still too early to determine its strength, with clearer signals likely by May.
- India's Agriculture Ministry has approved procurement of over 0.125 million MT of rabi crops in Telangana under the Price Support Scheme (PSS) at MSP. The procurement includes gram, urad, groundnut and sunflower, with a total approved value of over ₹894 crore, aimed at protecting farmers from market fluctuations and ensuring remunerative prices.
- The National Cooperative Consumers' Federation of India (NCCF) pulses tender results announced on 11 March 2026 show sales of Masoor, Chana and Moong stocks from warehouses in Bhopal and Kanpur. Masoor and Gram traded around ₹5,300–₹5,533/quintal, while Moong fetched higher bids near ₹6,800–₹7,134/quintal, indicating relatively stronger demand for Moong.
- Australia Chana Vessel Update: The vessel MV. ROSTRUM HAMBURG carrying 17,052 MT of Desi Chickpeas (Chana) from Australia is expected to arrive at Mundra Port on 15 March 2026, according to shipping agency reports.
- The Supreme Court of India has emphasized the need to encourage farmers to shift towards pulses cultivation, noting that farmers often prefer crops they consider safer. The court suggested that the government should promote crop diversification and ensure better MSP support and assured marketing to boost pulses production and protect farmers' incomes.
- Packaged food companies across the country have halted or reduced production at plants using liquefied petroleum gas (LPG) due to an acute fuel shortage, with some also reporting disruptions in piped natural gas (PNG) supplies, impacting manufacturing operations.
- U.S. Gulf soybean spot prices weakened amid uncertain demand from China and strong competition from newly harvested supplies in Brazil. However, soybean futures on Chicago Board of Trade rose to their highest level since mid-2024, supported by higher crude oil prices, stronger soybean oil demand for biodiesel, and speculative buying ahead of potential U.S.–China trade discussions.

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
