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News Highlights

- *IMD has issued an orange alert for heavy to very heavy rainfall over Arunachal Pradesh, Bihar, Sub-Himalayan West Bengal and Sikkim, with heavy rain expected across several parts of north, central, east, west and southern India. Thunderstorms, lightning and gusty winds are also likely in parts of southern and northeastern India.*
- *Today's pulses market was mixed: Tur weakened in Chennai while remaining steady in Akola and Solapur. Chana was mixed, Urad remained largely stable with a slight rise in Delhi, and Moong was firm in Delhi but weaker in Jabalpur. Masoor gained in Delhi, while Matar remained unchanged across major markets.*
- *NAFED has invited bids to supply 7,000 MT of Masoor Dal (unpolished) per month to ASC/OCS district godowns across Assam, from October 2026 to March 2027. Technical bids are scheduled to open on 11 August 2026.*
- *Gujarat's kharif pulses sowing as of 3 August 2026 stood at 0.242 million hectares, up 8.8% from 0.222 million hectares last year. Moong acreage declined 64.4%, while Urad increased 32.5% and Moth rose 6.8%.*
- *Chennai Pulses Import (25–31 July 2026): Chennai imported 26,550 MT of pulses in 1,062 containers during 25–31 July 2026. Myanmar Urad accounted for the largest share at 17,525 MT, followed by Brazil Urad (5,325 MT), Myanmar Tur (2,450 MT), Tanzania Tur (1,100 MT), and Canada Masoor (150 MT).*
- *The NCCF–PSS Sale Confirmation dated 01.08.2026 shows the confirmed sale of Moong (green gram) and Urad procured under the Price Support Scheme (PSS). The table lists details such as the branch, warehouse, season (K-25), sale rate (₹ per quintal), and quantity sold (in MT). Most of the sales are from Jaipur warehouses, with sale rates ranging from about ₹6,501 to ₹6,723 per quintal. This report helps ensure transparency in the sale of government-procured pulses.*
- *Australia Weather: A series of cold fronts and low-pressure systems brought showers and isolated thunderstorms to southern Australia, with snowfall in elevated areas. Weekly rainfall reached 50–100 mm in parts of Tasmania, while southern Queensland and New South Wales also received useful rainfall, with totals of up to 100 mm along Queensland's tropical coast.*
- *Edible oil prices rose in the evening session in the global market. Malaysian palm oil futures closed higher, while soybean oil prices in Chicago also gained. Traders said Malaysian crude palm oil futures were supported by gains in Chicago soybean oil, a strong recovery in crude oil prices, and a slightly weaker ringgit.*

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
